This summer, I will be traveling to Africa (June 30-July 14). This is my first time on the continent. My first stop will be in Uganda where we will serve Bless the Children Ministries. This ministry focuses on orphaned children in Uganda. We will be providing personal financial coaching for their 60 national staffers. We are really excited about this new partnership and hope get a good look at their ministry as we try to help their staff grow in financial stewardship.

Next I will spend a couple of day in Kenya connecting with African Christian **Outreach (ACO)** and their staff. I have known the director of ACO since he was a student involved in our college ministry. I am also hoping to spend a couple of days with some great friends of ours in Zambia with the **Navigators** on the way back.

As He ascended back to heaven, He gave His disciples a mandate to spread the gospel to the ends of the earth and to make disciples of all the nations (Matthew 28:18-20). We call that mandate the Great Commission. The Christian family has a responsibility to fulfill this mandate in our generation. This will take time, talent, and treasure. Two of the biggest challenges to the Great Commission are 1) Christians willing to spread His Word 2) Christians willing to give to His work. In this book, we

are writing about how to fund the mission. It is time to transition our thinking from the organizations financed to the primary funder- the Christian family.
